

## Visitor visa for France

Document	Description
1. Recent, developed identity photos	1 recent passport-sized colour photograph. Size 3.5 cm x 4.5 cm, with white background, taken within 6 months and not damaged and stapled.
2. Schengen application form, original	<p>1 completed Schengen visa application form duly filled in, dated and signed.</p> <p><b>Minors: (under the age of 18)</b></p> <p>Both parents must sign the visa application forms and add copies of their passports as well as the full version of the birth certificate of the child with a copy. If there is only one guardian please present the legal documentation thereof, (divorce papers, birth or death certificate etc.). If one parent is unable to sign the forms, he/she must submit a letter of agreement together with a copy of his/her passport bearing the signature of the holder. If the child is travelling with only one parent, the written consent of the other parent is required as well as a copy of the passport of the latter bearing the signature.</p>
3. Last page of the application form with signatures	The last page of the application form with declaration containing signatures of the applicant himself/herself.
4. Passport, original	Passport, signed by the holder. The passport should not be older than 10 years, valid at least 3 months beyond the exit from the Schengen area and contain at least 2 empty pages.
5. Passport, copy	Copy of the applicant's valid passport (Inside front cover containing holder's personal information and photo; Inside back cover containing "Important reminders", signature and other passport information; copy of any previous Schengen visa received.
6. Resident ID permit OR Migration card and Work permit, copy	Citizens of other countries, living in Kazakhstan, should present a resident ID permit issued by the competent local authority (Migration Police) or a migration card and work permit issued by the Akimat.
7. Letter of authorization for the submission by a representative, original	(Please check special conditions to submit visa application through a Representative in the Section "FAQ – <a href="#">Can someone else apply for a visa</a>

<b>8. Representative ID Card or passport, original</b> <b>Representative ID Card or passport, copy</b>	
<b>9. Attestation d'accueil, original</b>  <b>Attestation d'accueil, copy</b>	“Attestation d’accueil” (Proof of accommodation) issued by the town hall of residence of the inviting person
<b>10. Passport of inviter, copy</b>	Copy of the passport of the inviting person.
<b>11. Residence permit of inviter, copy</b>	Copy of the residence permit of the inviting person (Swiss citizens only passport).
<b>12. Employment certificate / working certificate/study certificate, original</b>  <b>Employment certificate / working certificate, translation (English, French, German or Italian)</b>	Certificate of employment with indication of position, beginning of contract and present monthly salary. The certificate of employment should show a proper letter head including address, telephone, fax and e-mail address. A copy of the employer’s tax number needs to be joined to the certificate if it’s not obvious on the certificate.  <b>Minors: (under the age of 18):</b> Study certificate is necessary for minors
<b>12. Alternative Documents</b>	Any documents proving strong ties to the country of residence such as land, property ownership, bank savings, deposits, family members staying in the country of residence, birth, marriage certificates, children at school etc on the applicant's own decision.
<b>12. Copy of visa of accompanying person (for minors)</b>	Shenghen visa should be valid for the period of trip
<b>13. Copy of flight of accompanying person (for minors)</b>	Flight reservation with confirmed departure and return.
<b>14. Sponsorship letter, original</b>	It must be original or notarized copy
<b>15. Bank statement of the applicant covering the last three months, original</b>  <b>Bank statement of the applicant covering the last three months, translation (English, French,</b>	If the applicant travels on his/her own business purposes: Bank statement over the last 3 months to cover the costs of living in Switzerland/France (additionally to hotel and transportation costs min. CHF 100.00 per day in Switzerland and EUR 65.00 in France  <b>Minors: (under the age of 18)</b> Sponsor's bank statement in original or notarized

<b>German or Italian)</b>	copy.
<b>16. Medical insurance, original</b>	Travel Medical Insurance which covers the Schengen area with an amount of min. EUR 30'000.00 for the whole period of the whole travel (or in case of a two entry visa both travels). For multiple visas: the first travel has to be covered (the relevant field on the last page of the application form has to be signed).

<b>17. Round-trip flight ticket reservation, copy</b>	Flight reservation with confirmed departure and return.
